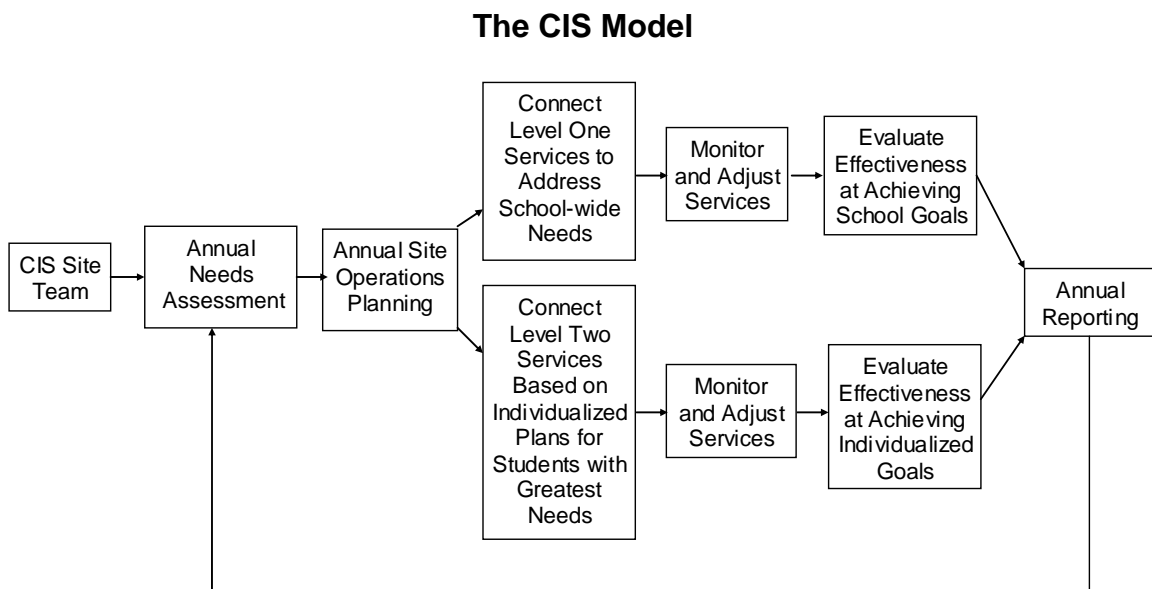


# The CIS Model

How does CIS bring about needed changes at school sites and in the lives of the students? The answer lies in a simple yet highly effective model for delivering integrated, evidence-based services to address school and individual student level needs. The following illustration shows how the CIS Model is implemented throughout the school year by a CIS site team. The process is cyclical, with the evaluative information from one year being used as part of data-driven decision making for the next year of implementation.



## Level One Services

Level One Services Are:
Focused on prevention
Designed to build student assets
Short term
Designed to address identified school-wide needs

Examples of Level One Services
Career fairs
Clothes closet
School supplies
Health screenings
Red Ribbon Week
Gang prevention presentations

## Level Two Services

Level Two Services Are:
Targeted for individual students experiencing one or more risk factors
Intended for students and/or families with specific needs
Sustained interventions lasting weeks, months or an entire school year
Designed to achieve one or more tracked outcomes, such as improved academic performance, attendance or behavior

Examples of Level Two Services
Anger management groups
Life skills training
Family strengthening group
Weekly tutoring sessions
Lunch Buddies mentoring program
Career mentors
College access program
